




Black Horse Leatherworks

Custom Made Schooling Chaps

Term	Definition	measurements				
Chap Waist	Measure all the way around the waist at the LEVEL YOU WANT THE CHAPS TO RIDE ON YOUR WAIST. If a lower waist style is preferred, measure around that point.	-

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Above Knee	Measure just above the top of the knee cap (approx. 3" above)	<table border="1" style="width: 100%;"> <tr> <td style="text-align: center;">Left</td> <td style="text-align: center;">Right</td> </tr> <tr> <td style="text-align: center;">-</td> <td style="text-align: center;">-</td> </tr> </table>	Left	Right	-	-
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Knee	Measure the center of the knee cap.	<table border="1" style="width: 100%;"> <tr> <td style="text-align: center;">Left</td> <td style="text-align: center;">Right</td> </tr> <tr> <td style="text-align: center;">-</td> <td style="text-align: center;">-</td> </tr> </table>	Left	Right	-	-
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Calf	Measure the fullest part of the calf. If tall boots will be worn, make sure to put the tape measure around the boot tops as they will be larger than the leg.-	<table border="1" style="width: 100%;"> <tr> <td style="text-align: center;">Left</td> <td style="text-align: center;">Right</td> </tr> <tr> <td style="text-align: center;">-</td> <td style="text-align: center;">-</td> </tr> </table>	Left	Right	-	-

Left	Right					
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Ankle	Measure just above the ankle bone over paddock boot or whatever shoes will be worn.	-				
Inseam	Beginning at the crotch level, measure down to heel of your boot. Should be about ½" from the floor.	-				
Rise	Place the beginning of your tape measure at the level you want chaps fitting up on the waist and measure downward to a point that would be in line with the crotch. Your purpose is to measure how high up the torso you want the top of your chaps to sit.	-				
To the middle of Knee	Measure from your crotch or top of thigh level down the front of your leg to the center of the kneecap.	-				
Knee to Calf	Measure from center of kneecap down to fullest part of calf.	-				
Total length of chap	With your tape measure at the top of chap on your waist, measure down the front of the leg, keeping your measuring tape against the leg to the desired length at the instep of the foot.	-				
Bottom style	Don't forget to let me know which bottom style you would like!	-				

Pull the measuring tape to a comfortable snugness or how you want the chaps to fit. DO NOT PULL THE TAPE TIGHT but do keep in mind that the leather will stretch slightly.



Customer Service Policy

Limited Product Warrantee: Black Horse Leatherworks will guarantee its products to be free from defect of materials or workmanship for 6 months from time of receipt. Normal wear and tear is to be expected and not covered by the warrantee. Once the product is returned to Black Horse Leatherworks, it will be repaired or replaced upon our discretion. Colors chosen can also vary slightly with the sample swatches. We are not responsible for this – we will always get the best match possible.

Shipments: Custom chap orders will be shipped within 4 - 6 weeks of receipt of the completed order form accompanied by a 50% deposit. Balance due upon completion of the chaps. Total balance due and shipping costs (if applicable) must be paid before chaps are shipped or paid at time of pick-up. Delays in shipping may be caused by temporary unavailability of supplies, incomplete order information, inadequate deposit, changes or additions to the original order. Customers will be notified of any of the above delays.

Rush orders: Rush orders will be shipped 3 weeks from receipt of the completed order form accompanied by a 50% deposit, and incurring a \$100.00 rush fee, Any special shipping requested will be charged accordingly.

Repairs and alterations: Black Horse Leatherworks offer repairs and alterations, by quote, on any chaps.

Returns: If there is a problem with your custom chaps, please notify Black Horse Leatherworks within 10 days of receipt. Any problem resulting from an error on our part will be corrected at no expense to the customer. Black Horse Leatherworks cannot held responsible for mistakes on order information or measurements provided by the customer, however we will cooperate to fix the problem. Please measure carefully!

Cancellations: There are no cancellations. Orders with deposits, once received by Black Horse Leatherworks are a binding contract. Supplies are ordered immediately upon receipt, therefore deposits will not be returned.

Changes to Orders: Changes can be accepted if production is not too far along to accommodate them.
